The Erie All-City Marching Band and Boosters are asking for your support of another great Competition Season.

The Erie All-City Marching Band (known as EACMB) was formed in 2002 when the Erie School District consolidated all four High School Marching Bands into one citywide Marching Band for students of all of Erie's Middle and High Schools.

One of the many wonderful things about EACMB is that there are no prior musical ability requirements to join the Band. Our dedicated and skilled Band Staff works with each the students to teach them everything they need to learn to be an effective part of the organization.

Weekly rehearsal and practice sessions are held at Strong Vincent High School under the leadership of Band Director Mr. Erick Nicklas.

Each summer the EACMB Boosters host and fund an Annual Band Camp at Camp Sherwin. This is a week-long event dedicated to creating a 24/7 environment of Teamwork, Social Integration, Skill Building Lessons and more! The Booster Staff provides Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner and a Late Night Snack each day.

Erie All-City Marching Band performs in several parades around the region as well as football games at Veteran's Memorial Stadium.

EACMB competes in the Lakeshore Marching Band Association (LMBA) Circuit each year during the months of September and October. As part of the LMBA Circuit, Erie All-City Marching Band is honored to host the annual LMBA Championship Competition. Friends and families of 15 plus area and regional high school marching bands gear up all season to attend and participate in the LMBA Championship Competition which is held at Veteran's Memorial Stadium on the last Saturday of October.

Every year our organization exists requires financial support. As you may be aware funding for extra-curricular activities from the school district is extremely limited. So much so, the district is considering cutting any and all programs and extra-curricular activities that are not self-supporting. So yes, once again we are asking for your support.
