The following three background checks are required:

- Pennsylvania State Police Request for Criminal Records Check
- Department of Human Services Child Abuse History Clearance
- Federal Criminal History Record Information—FBI Fingerprint (CHRI)

1. Act 34: Pennsylvania Criminal History

To be provided by the applicant and reviewed by the school (or higher education administrator) prior to the applicant working in a position in which he will have direct contact with children.

3. Federal Criminal History Record Information (CHRI)

The fingerprint-based background check is a multiple-step process, as follows:

- Registration The applicant must register prior to going to the fingerprint site at https://uenroll.identogo.com.
 Use Service Code: 1KG6XN
- Select "Schedule or Manage Appointment". Complete the application.
- Proceed to fingerprint location with acceptable identification. (See IdentoGo website for the list of acceptable documents).
- Provide UEID number to Erie's Public Schools.

INSTRUCTIONS

Pursuant to 24 P.S. §1-111(c.4) and (j), the Pennsylvania Department of Education developed this standardized form (PDE-6004) to be used by current and prospective employees of public and private schools, intermediate units, and area vocational-technical schools.

As required by subsection (c.4) and (j)(2) of 24 P.S. §1-111, this form shall be completed and submitted by all current and prospective employees of said institutions to provide written reporting of any arrest or conviction for an offense enumerated under 24 P.S. §§1-111(e) and (f.1) and to provide notification of having been named as a perpetrator of a founded report of child abuse within the past five (5) years as defined by the Child Protective Services Law.

As required by subsection (j)(4) of 24 P.S. §1-111, this form also shall be utilized by current and prospective employees to provide written notice within seventy-two (72) hours after a subsequent arrest or conviction for an offense enumerated under 24 P.S. §§1-111(e) or (f.1).

In accordance with 24 P.S. §1-111, employees completing this form are required to submit the form to the administrator or other person responsible for employment decisions in a school entity. Please contact a supervisor or the school entity administration office with any questions regarding the PDE 6004, including to whom the form should be sent.

 - Section 3124.2 (relating to institutional sexual assault)
 - Section 3125(relating to aggravated indecent assault)
 - Section 3126 (relating to indecent assault)
 - Section 3127 (relating to indecent exposure)
 - Section 3129 (relating to sexual intercourse with animal)
 - Section 4302 (relating to incest)
 - Section 4303 (relating to concealing death of child)

- Section 4304 (relating to endangering welfare of children)
- Section 4305 (relating to dealing in infant children)

 - · the United States; or
 - · one of its territories or possessions: or
 - · another state; or
 - · the District of Columbia; or
 - · the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico; or
 - · a foreign nation; or
 - · under a former law of this Commonwealth.
- A reportable offense enumerated under 24 P.S. §1-111(f.1) consists of any of the following:
 - (1) An offense graded as a felony offense of the first, second or third degree, other than one of the offenses enumerated under 24 P.S. §1-111(e), if less than (10) ten years has elapsed from the date of expiration of the sentence for the offense.
 - (2) An offense graded as a misdemeanor of the first degree, other than one of the offenses enumerated under 24 P.S. §1-111(c), if less than (5) five years has clapsed from the date of expiration of the sentence for the offense.
 - (3) An offense under 75 Pa.C.S. § 3802(a), (b), (c) or (d)(relating to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled substance) graded as a misdemeanor of the first degree under 75 Pa.C.S. § 3803 (relating to grading), if the person has been previously convicted of such an offense and less than (3) three years has elapsed from the date of expiration of the sentence for the most recent offense.
